DYNEVER was reserved for a half, rallied strongly while between horses five wide on the turn, battled heads apart in midstretch then drew clear under right hand encouragement. SUPAH BLITZ trailed for five furlongs, circled six wide on the turn, gained a slim lead in upper stretch but couldn't stay with the winner through the final eighth. MASSIVE stalked three wide along the backstretch, dropped back slightly between horses on the turn then continued on willingly to gain a share. WHITE BUCK saved ground to the turn then failed to threaten while improving his position. POPULAR GROOM failed to mount a serious rally. VALID VIDEO raced up close along the rail into upper stretch and gave way. VALENZO was used up setting the early pace. UNBRIDELS KING raced within striking distance while four wide to the turn and faltered. PRIVATE CITY raced between rivals to the turn and gave way.
