MR. DECATUR sat in a good stalking position down the backside, bid three wide at the half, was under a determined drive through the stretch and took the lead in the final strides. EXCESSIVEPLEASURE got carried wide on the first turn but moved to the front while in hand onto the backside, took the rail going after a half, responded gamely to the challenge on the far turn, duelled throughout the drive and had a narrow advantage into deep stretch only to be beaten. FLARIONS FLAME improved position four wide in the lane and was up for the show at the sixteenth. ES SPECIAL was within reach two wide on the far turn, angled four out nearing the stretch but had no kick left. NATIVE TEXAN bid two wide between the top two nearing the far turn only to tire in the drive. MANZOTTI QUEEN was no factor. DOUBLE INTRIGUE gave chase from inside but was empty in the stretch. OCEAN AFFAIR had inside speed for a half before tiring badly and coasting home.
