MR. TECHNIQUE raced unhurried for a half, shifted out and bid three wide into the far turn, came four deep into the stretch, rallied under strong urging and closed quickly, took the lead at the sixteenth pole then was in hand late while inching away. APALACHIAN THUNDER stalked the pace menacingly to the half, was asked and responded on the second turn, drew clear to mid stretch but was tiring in the final sixteenth. TRIBE raced three wide to the backstretch, settled to the second turn, was asked for speed while outside a rival on the second bend but finished evenly in the drive. RISK REWARD had no speed but saved ground to the far turn then could not come up with a response in the drive. SOUVENIR'S LAD had the best speed and dropped over to save ground while setting the pace to the half, briefly met a bid on the second turn then had little left for the drive. EXCESSIVE BARB threw his head and lunged at the start, recovered and tracked the pace to the backstretch, fell away after six furlongs and faded in the drive.
