CROWNED KING unhurried early, began to move along the inside backstretch, contention along the rail second turn under clever handling; angled out when straightened for home, bid then edged clear in the late going. GREAT NOTION broke out, ran a quick opening quarter while four wide first turn, clear early backstretch, continued at a rapid clip into the second turn, could not contain the winner, well clear of the others. COMIC TRUTH settled off the early pace and the rail, lacked clear room in the second turn while in traffic, clear stretch, lacked the needed closing kick. SIR CHEROKEE with the pace into the first turn, steadied when in tight soon after, settled backstretch, four wide turning for home, came up empty. ALKE chased the leader for just under six furlongs, little left for the drive. ANTSY was never close. POWER LION briefly forward, bumped first turn, stopped, far back.
