1 MILE. (1.332) 23rd Running of THE SAN RAFAEL. Grade II. Purse \$200,000 Guaranteed. THREE-YEAR-OLDS. By subscription of \$200 each to accompany the nomination or by supplementary nomination of \$4,000 by time of entry. \$2,000 additional to start. Early bird nominees to the 2003 Santa Anita Derby (Closing Date Monday, December 9, 2002) are automatically eligible to the San Rafael Stakes with all fees waived. Weight: 121 lbs. Non-winners of \$70,000 at one mile or over allowed 3 lbs.; of a race of \$40,000 at any distance, 6 lbs. Early nominations closed December 9 with 149. Closed Thursday, February 20, 2003 with 3.

ROJO TORO pulled his way up three deep on the first turn, dueled outside a rival on the backstretch and second turn, inched away in the stretch and held on gamely under urging. SPENSIVE angled in and pulled a bit stalking the pace toward the inside, went outside a rival on the second turn and four wide into the stretch, lugged in some in the drive but continued willingly to the wire. CROWNED DANCER a bit wide into the first turn, stalked outside on the backstretch and three deep on the second turn, was between horses in midstretch, could not match either of the top pair but bested the rest. OUR BOBBY V. sped to the early lead inside, dueled along the rail on the backstretch and second turn and weakened in the final furlong. SUM TRICK tracked the pace a bit off the rail then between horses into the stretch and lacked the needed response. JUST WONDER (GB) settled outside then chased between horses, continued toward the inside leaving the backstretch and on the second turn and weakened. IRON LAD (IRE) allowed to settle off the pace, came out from the rail into the backstretch, trailed off the inside and was outrun.
