FIVE STAR GENERAL was away in good order, prompted the pace to the outside of STRONG QUALITLY to the stretch, weake ned slightly during the drive but stayed on to preserve the show spot. DENINGTON lagged far back, came under a ride with three furlongs to run, got through entering the stretch, swung to the far outside, finished well but was left with too much to do. BEST ACTOR was unhurried betw een horses, came undera ride on the turn, came four wideand finished with a mild im pr ov ement. OSCAR ECLIPSE was forwardly placed four wide through the turn and flattened. COLLABORATE settled saving ground, shifted out enter ing the lane and finished with a belated improvement. U. S. ARMY contended five wide for a half and dropped out. NOT N ORMAL attended the pace towards the inside through the turnand retreated. STRAVA was allowed to settle, looped into the stretch six widebut lacked a response.
