MYSTIK DAN tracked the leaders in rail skimming fashion, slipped through to makea bold bid nearing the quarter pole, came to level terms entering the stretch, shook clear approaching the furlong marker, dugin doggedly and was fully extended to prevail by the slimmest of margins. SIERRA LEONE settled in hand, tucked in along the rail, shifted out a bit on the backstretch, took closer order between rivals through the second turn, worked his way out eight wide entering the stretch, exchanged bumps with FOREVER YOUNG (JPN) from the three-sixteenths pole to the furlong grounds, fought on tenaciously under stern left handed urging but was denied. FOREVER YOUNG (JPN) lunged at the start and was away slow, was caught in traffic into the first turn and steadied near the fifteen-sixteenths pole, leveled into stride and moved out five wide, mounted a long drive a half mile out, moved up swiftly through the second turn, came seven wide into the stretch, swapped bumps repeatedly with SIERRA LEONE through the upper stretch, battled on stubbornly between rivals thereafter but was narrowly bested. CATCHING FREEDOM settled off of the inside, tucked in on the second turn, followed the winner into the lane along the inside, continued on well and was making up ground. TO PASSWORD (JPN) broke a step slow, checked in trafficinto the first turn, settled off the inside into the backstretch, came under a ride nearing the seven-sixteenths pole, looped seven wide through the second turn and into the stretch, had the jockey lose the crop near the furlong marker and continued on well under a fierce hand ride. RESILIENCE settled in pursuit from midpack three wide, ranged up with a bold six wide gain turning for home to bid along with inner rivals entering the lane but failed to keep pace with his innermost counterpart in upper stretch, got outkicked for place between rivals in midstretch and yielded. STRONGHOLD stalked behind the leaders and from the three path around the first turn, came under rousing within striking range in the four path turning for home, bid along with rivals on both sides entering the lane, but failed to keep pace with his inner counterpart while getting brushed and floated inwardly by an outer rival in upper stretch and gave way. HONOR MARIE was jostled hard early between rivals, settled toward the inside, was caught in traffic and steadied into the first turn, leveled into stride while saving ground, moved up on the second turn, veered out sharply inside the three-sixteenths and boxed on willingly. ENDLESSLY leaned outwardly at the start, was allowed to settle at the rear along the inside, improved in the three to four

FOREVER YOUNG (JPN) lunged at the start and was away slow, was caught in traffic into the first turn and steadied near the fifteen-sixteenths pole, leveled into stride and moved out five wide, mounted a long drive a half mile out moved up swiftly through the second turn, came seven wide into the stretch, swapped bumps repeatedly with SIERRA LEONE through the upper stretch, battled on stubbornly between rivals thereafter but was narrowly bested. CATCHING FREEDOM settled off of the inside, tucked in on the second turn, followed the winner into the lane along the inside, continued on well andwas making up ground. TO PASSWORD (JPN) broke a step slow, checked in trafficinto the first turn, settled off the inside into the backstretch, came under a ride nearing the seven-sixteenths pole, looped seven wide through the second turn and into the stretch, had the jockey lose the crop near the furlong marker and continued on well under a fierce hand ride. HONOR MARIE was jostled hard early between rivals, settled toward the inside, was caught intraffic and steadied into the first turn, leveled into stride while saving ground, moved up on the second turn, veered out sharply inside the three-sixteenths and boxed on willingly.

ENDLESSLY leaned outwardv at the start, was allowed to settle at the rear along the inside, improved in the three to path and between horses around the far turn before swinging ten wide into the land, then moved up willingly without reaching contention. DORNOCH settled saving ground, was shuffled back in traffic inside the half mile marker, came again between foes, was bumped and checke dhard of f heels near the quarter pole, angled out into the stretch but came up empty in the driver. TACK
PHANTOM showed the way inside of a pair of prompting fees, remained hounded inside of rivals one path off the rail around the
far turn but was headed by challengers on either side entering the lane and folded. WEST SARATOGA raced for wardly two wide and between horses, chased from the two to three path around the far turn, was bumped and jostled by an inner rival to the four to five path entering thelane, was brushed again by an inner foe in upper stretch and gave way. DOMESTIC PRODUCT broke a step slow before being bumped and pinched between horses at the start, tugged while off of the pace four wide into the first turn, got brushed and put into tight quarters between foes while getting out moved by a wider rival around the far turn, shifted to the nine path into the lane and passed tired ones. EPIC RIDE stalked outside of the leading trio, came under a drive in the five path and between horses around the far turn but retreated entering the lane then shied from an inner foe and brushed an outer rival at th three sixteenths pole and faded. FIER CENESS hopped at the start, prompted the pace three deep, vied in the four path around the far turn, but was sur passed by an outer pair and an inner bidder entering the lane and folded between horses. SOCIETY MAN raced off of the pace four wide, then faded between horses around the far turn. JUST STEEL was bumped hard early, was quickly into stride and contested the pace between horses, faltered midway through the second turn and faded. GRAND MO THE FIRST brushed an inner rival at the start, steadied among foes passing the wire for the first time, laid well back in the three path, came under urging in the four path approaching the five furlong pole then gave way in the six path around the far turn. CATALYTIC contended along the inside to the second turn and dropped out. JUST A TOUCH was bumped early, settled between horses, moved into contention

on the second turn, was bumped in traffic near the five-sixteenths pole and came up empty the reafter.
