CANDY OVERLOAD was allowed to settle into stride mid-pack, made a rapid advance inside rivals coming to the fivesixteenths, was guided out four wideat the top of the stretch seeking room, split foes to bid near ing the eighth pole, duel ed inside a rival bef ore edging away from that one to prevail. FLAG OF HONOUR (AUS) settled mid-division, advanced outside four then five wide midway on the turn, bid outside the ev entual winner near the furlong grounds witha real threat but was out finished and only second best. IRONSTONE settled off the pace, saved some ground on the turn, ralliedinside foes in mid-stretch and was best of the rest. JAZZ HANDS was encouraged from the start and soon made the lead and moved clear, set the pace just off the rail, came out a bit leaving the turn when challenged, was ov ertaken by mid-str etch and kept on evenly thereafter. ARMSTRONG was up close stalking the pacesetter from outside, traveled three to four wide onthet urn while dropping back off the leaders but kept on in the stretch. SK Y'S N OT FALLING settled off the pace racing between foes at the back, went three to four wide on the turn, needed more. ROCKCREST was in just a hair tight early, shifted in to track the pace inside, moved out on the turn coming alongside the leaderthree wide at the quarter pole, floated five wide into upper str etch, flattened out. BIZ BIZ BUZZ settled outside off the pace four to five wide through the turn, swung seven deep into upper str etch, failed to rally.
